tubes & bulbs • Stereos • VCR &
DVD players • Mercury thermostats
and thermometers • Computers •
Phones (cordless & cell) • Printers
and printer cartridges • Batteries
(household, button & rechargeable) •
Clothing irons • Video game
equipment and game cartridges

Helpful Tips

- Limit of 125 lbs. or 15 gallons in 5-gallon or smaller containers per vehicle.
- Containers must be sound, sealed and not leaking.
- Keep material in its original container or label the contents clearly. **DO NOT MIX MATERIALS.**
- Place items securely in a cardboard box in your trunk or truck bed with any necessary padding such as newspaper to keep glass containers from breaking during transport.
- At the site, staff will unload your items for you. Please stay in your vehicle.
